



Year 10: Curriculum Overview 2025–2026

Please find below an overview of the subjects and topics your child will study during Year 10, as they begin their Key Stage 4 journey and work towards Level 2 qualifications. All students follow our **core curriculum**, which includes:

- **English Language**
- **English Literature**
- **Mathematics**
- **Science** (Combined Science, unless **Triple Science** was chosen as one of their four option subjects)

In addition to these examined subjects, students take part in our **core enrichment curriculum**, which includes:

- **Physical Education (PE)**
- **Personal Development Curriculum (PDC)** – incorporating **Religious Studies**, careers education, health and wellbeing, and social, moral, spiritual and cultural learning
- **Tutor Time**, which supports personal development and further enriches the overall curriculum offer

Alongside the core curriculum, students choose **four option subjects** from a **broad and balanced range**. These options allow students to pursue individual interests and talents, while developing knowledge and skills that support future pathways into further education, apprenticeships or employment.

Our curriculum is designed to be both ambitious and inclusive, ensuring every student is challenged, supported and inspired to achieve their full potential.
