Activity	Evidence
Read the instructions to make or do something. It could be a model, a craft project or board game.	photograph the instructions / photograph what you have made.
Create something delicious by reading a new recipe from a cookbook or online recipe website.	Photograph the recipe and what you made.
Using the book you are currently reading, or one you recently read, create a storyboard of one scene in the book.	Photograph the storyboard.
Read the first page of 4 books you have never read before.	List the books and say which first page you liked most.
In 100 words or less write a new version of a well known fairytale. For example, Goldilocks might get eaten by baby bear.	The story.
Using the search term <i>BBC science news</i> find an article you find interesting and write 2 things you learned from it.	The 2 things you learned.
Read a poem and draw a picture that illustrates, all or part of, the poem.	The picture.
Choose a subject that interests you and use the internet or books to find out 2 things you didn't already know about that subject.	Write the 2 things you didn't know and the websites or book titles you used.
