Luggage Allowance

Each person on the flight will be entitled to:

Virgin Atlantic Airways

Hand Luggage: One piece not exceeding 10 kg and no bigger than 23 cm x 36 cm x 56 cm including the handle, pockets and wheels

Checked Luggage: One piece not exceeding 23 kg and no bigger than 90 cm x 75 cm x 43 cm







Medication on the plane

If medication (liquids over 100ml), needles or EpiPens are needed to be carried on board the aircraft, the passenger will require a letter from their Doctor dated within 1 month prior to travel to confirm what the medication is and what it is for. This will then need to be shown at the airport upon request.



Our expectations:



- Students over 16 will have some independence, must ensure they follow timings and instructions

 - sensitivity at airports/customs/entering US/attractions
- Remain as a group, look out for each other.
- You must stay in your allocated bedroom!
- Drinking alcohol law in US is 21 and over. Sodas for all!
- Smoking law in New York cannot buy tobacco under 21,
 - no smoking in public places





Travel Tips





Passport:

All students travelling must hold a full passport

Visa:

Each passenger MUST have a valid ESTA visa.

Each visa is valid for 2 years and costs \$14

Travel Insurance

. Please be advised you will need to contact the FOGG Travel Insurance Referral Helpline to declare <u>any pre-existing medical</u> <u>conditions</u> for your child. Please call **0845 1300 198** from Monday to Friday between 09:00-17:00 hrs. FOGG will only discuss the condition with the Insured (or parent). You should let FOGG know that they will travel on a school trip with NST to New York City. FOGG will then advise if the condition is covered as part of our pre-agreed Travel Insurance Policy. If the condition isn't covered, they may be able to offer premium cover. It is then down to the individual if they want to pay the additional cost directly to FOGG.

Please note that mobile phones are <u>not</u> covered under FOGG insurance.





Spending Money:

Travel Tips

- The currency in New York is the American Dollar.
- We recommend that students take cash/card.

Amount – investigate if there are any particular items you want to buy

- Lunch each day (suggest \$20 per day)
- Souvenirs
- Clothes/Shoes check what the US size is they are not the same
- Electrical goods different voltages be aware of this

Tell the bank and phone company you will be abroad if you use your card and phone



Travel Tips

What to take on the trip:

• Towel

- Toiletries
- Sensible walking shoes
- Warm clothes layers it could be very cold
- Gloves, scarf and hat
- Sleeping bag liner/sheet
- Luggage allowance is <u>23kg</u> maximum in both directions (plus one piece of hand luggage)
- Plus do not put any liquids into hand luggage
- Check charges with your mobile phone provider







- Secure bag for day time use
- Travel light security checks
- Passport holder / wallet
