

Transition: Student information about Transition and key dates.

Transition this year will be very different to that of previous years. We know that the opportunity to visit the school, meet form tutors and attend the parental information evening will not be taking place as per the government guidance.

Please be reassured that your transition/induction to secondary school remains a high priority for us at Fulston Manor School and we are therefore working 'behind the scenes' to ensure that your transition goes as smoothly as possible. Our Pastoral team have contacted every Primary School, therefore ensuring that key information is shared prior to you starting in September.

Please note that we are currently planning for the following transition opportunities:

YEAR 6 TRANSITION: MEET THE STAFF

We are producing a short video which will introduce key staff to you, notably the Heads of House. This will be sent out to Primary Schools and parents to share with you. This will be posted on our school website from the 22nd June.

VIRTUAL TOUR

We understand the importance of you being able to familiarise yourself with your new surroundings. We have produced a virtual tour which will be made available on our school website (from the 22nd June) for you and your parents to view. The virtual tour will help you to orientate your way around the school in readiness for starting with us in the Autumn term.

VIRTUAL PARENTS' INFORMATION PRESENTATION – MONDAY 29TH JUNE

We are inviting your parents/guardians to watch an online presentation, which will be streamed online at 7:00pm on Monday 29th June. The aim of the presentation is to explain in detail how the school works, our expectations and how we plan to work together to ensure that you have the best start to your secondary school education. We will be introducing our pastoral team and will outline how you can ask any questions that may arise.

HOME-LEARNING AND TRANSITION BOOKLET

We understand that you and your parents/guardians are likely to have some anxiety surrounding the current situation and its impact on transition. We are also conscious that you may feel that with not being in school for a number of months you may feel ill-prepared for secondary school. For this reason, we have created a number of transition workbooks and a 30-day transition challenge for you to complete. This will be posted on our website on the 29th June. We will also be launching a transition home learning booklet for August, which will be sent out on the 20th July.

ENHANCED TRANSITION TOURS – AUGUST

We are offering a limited number of enhanced transition tours for those students who have Special Educational Needs, or students who are feeling particularly anxious about the transition to secondary school.
