RE: GCE RESULTS DAY, THURSDAY 13TH AUGUST

We will be issuing results in person on the results day, as we have done in previous years. These are published on Thursday 13th August. We are hopeful to see as many students as possible and offer our support and congratulations following what has been the strangest of academic years for them. There is some additional guidance on the Sixth Form page of the School's website:

I would strongly recommend that both you and your son/daughter read the appropriate information so you are aware of what will happen on the 13th August. I would also urge any student who is working to arrange time off, in order to be able to celebrate their results with friends and family or be able to have time to reflect and consider other options if the results are not quite the ones that were anticipated. It may also be a good idea to read this letter and the information again prior to results day. I would also remind students:-

- They should ensure they print off their UCAS forms before the end of term as the UCAS website closes down for a period in late July/early August. These forms are very helpful if clearing is needed.
- They should make sure they fully charge their mobile phone as accessing UCAS Track or telephoning universities can take some time.

Students will be able to collect their results from **8:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. on Thursday 13th August**. Students must arrive to school and enter via the 6th form pedestrian gate. If driving, they should arrive via car park gate C and park in the car park. We would kindly ask that parents/guardians do not enter the school buildings if attending with your son/daughter, as we need to be able to manage numbers.

Students should go up to S6/7; on arrival please sanitise your hands at the station provided. Students will then be able to collect results.

We will be offering support regarding UCAS and transition to next steps for students. This will be in S8/9 with Mr Vigeon and Miss Davies should it be needed. Mrs Demian will also be in the Library to offer careers guidance support for any student that needs it.

Students who have met their university offers should confirm this with staff who will be located in the Sixth Form Centre and who will have a list of their university choices. Please confirm this before leaving the premises so we can gain an accurate picture of all students' destinations.
