RE: BLENDED LEARNING TIMETABLE - SIXTH FORM

As you are aware, schools will now be closed for an extended period of time so most students will be working remotely from home. To ensure high quality provision, we will now move to a modified lockdown timetable. This timetable incorporates more breaks, to ensure students and staff have the opportunity to move away from the computer screen to maintain their physical and mental well-being. We also need to staff our Key Worker provision on site, so this allows some flexibility with regards to not expecting staff to be in two places at the same time. In some cases, this schedule provides additional staff during live lessons to answer questions or cover absence if teachers are unwell.

Students in 6th form will have lessons according to their usual timetables, most of which will be live. They need to take note of the change to the timings of the day. Staff may ask students to attend further workshops from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m.
