- No hats/headwear (except for cultural reasons)
- No flip flops
- Further restrictions may be required for particular subject areas in relation to health and safety requirements e.g. covered toe footwear for Science practical sessions
- Anything deemed inappropriate by the Sixth Form Team

Sixth Form Dress Code

Students need to follow the guidelines and ensure that clothes are "school appropriate" – decent, professional, clean and modest.

We have a gender-neutral dress code with a general principle of clothing being smart/casual. Hairstyles and other items should also reflect this principle.

There is no requirement on what a student should wear but rules on what you cannot wear are highlighted to the left.

Mobile Phone and Headphones Policy

Sixth Form students are able to use their phone in the Sixth Form Centre and dedicated outside eating area but are not allowed to use their phone or headphones around the school site or in lessons.
