



## **Fulston Manor School Child Protection Policy 2025 Student Version**

- **Your safety is important to us.** At Fulston Manor School, we try to make sure everyone feels safe and happy. Our teachers and your House staff are always looking out for you, and will listen if you have a concern.
- **Your Safeguarding Team:** You may hear the word safeguarding used in school. It means that we have a responsibility to keep you safe and protected, both inside school and outside. We have a special team that's like a safety net, ready to help anyone who might need it. We're here to listen and take care of any worries you might have.
- **Who to talk to:** If you're feeling sad, scared, or just need someone to talk to, you can go to your House staff, your tutor or any teacher you are comfortable speaking with.
- You can also find one of our **Safeguarding Team** dotted around! Your Head of House, Ms Woollcott (B corridor), Mrs Mitchell and Mrs Franks (by Hales), Ms CB (Student Support Office) and many more; please see at the end for your full list of safeguarding staff.
- Your Designated Safeguarding Lead is Ms H Woollcott. My office is in B corridor, opposite the bottom of the stairs going up to IT. You can also email me on [hwoollcott@fulstonmanor.kent.sch.uk](mailto:hwoollcott@fulstonmanor.kent.sch.uk).
- **Learning to stay safe:** We teach you about how to stay safe in and out of school. Try to remember what we have said as we want you to know how to always keep yourself safe. It is also important that you keep yourself safe online; this includes not using apps outside of age

restrictions, or accessing material that may pose risks to you. We teach you about this in PDC, but if you are worried or would like some advice, please speak to somebody at school.

- Remember, if you ever feel like something is wrong or you just need to talk, you can always reach out to the people mentioned.
